



CENTRAL AAU TRAVEL TEAM LEAGUE RULES 2019

1. The playing rules shall be National Federation of State High School Association Rules for the current year except with the following modifications.
2. Time: (2) 20 minute halves running clock with the clock stopping on all whistles in the last minute of the 1st half and the last 2 minutes of the second half if the game is at 10 points or less. 1st Overtime is 2 minutes stop clock if the game is at 10 points or less. 2nd Overtime is sudden death, first team to score 2 points.
3. 2nd Grade & 3rd Grade will play with a 28.5" basketball.
4. Two (2) time outs per half, no carryovers. Overtime – one (1) time out - no carryovers.
5. Technicals on player will be shot. Technicals on bench will not be shot. 2 point award. Two (2) technicals on any coach associated with the team will mean a forfeit of game.
6. Bonus at the teams 7th foul in each half. NO DOUBLE BONUS!!!
7. **All defenses are allowed (Man to Man, Zone and Press)**

FULL COURT PRESS IS ALLOWED THE LAST 10 MINUTES OF THE SECOND HALF!!!

NO FULL COURT PRESS AFTER A TEAM IS AHEAD BY TEN POINTS!!!

Teams ahead by 20 points or more at any point in the second half must play defense behind their three point arc.

First offense: Warning, Second and all additional offenses: 2 shot technical.

8. A forfeit can be declared if a team arrives 10 minutes late for the posted game time.
9. Players can only play for one club or program in this league. A player is allowed to play on multiple teams with in the same club or program. An older player can not play down a grade level but a younger player can play up a grade level. Girls are allowed to play on boys teams.
10. Protests will be handled as follows:

Written protest must be filed within 30 minutes of the end of the game to be considered. \$100.00 CASH FEE WILL BE POSTED. If protest is lost you forfeit the \$100.00 fee. Brian Davis will decide on protest.

A valid IL State ID Card, passport or birth certificate and players' report card for each player is required at check in. Any person found to have an illegal birth certificate and players' report card will not be allowed to play and the team will forfeit all rights to play. In lieu of a birth certificate and report card a \$50.00 cash bond must be posted. If a valid birth certificate and report card is not produced within 6 hours of game time the bond and any team standings will be forfeited. School records will be used to determine grade, if age is not used.
